2	(1) The Commission comprises the following 11 members:,
3 4	(1) 5 members, to <u>WHO SHALL</u> be appointed by the Mayor in accordance with Article IV, § 6 of the City Charter;
5	(2) THE 11 MEMBERS SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:
6 7	(2) (I) 4 members, to be appointed <u>RECOMMENDED</u> by the President of the City Council;
8	(3) (II) the Police Commissioner or the Commissioner's designee; and
9	(4) (III) the Fire Chief or the Chief's designee.
10	(c) Qualifications.
11 12	(1) [Each] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, EACH appointed member must be a veteran.
13 14	(2) OF THE 4 MEMBERS APPOINTED RECOMMENDED BY THE CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT, 1 SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL, WHO NEED NOT BE A VETERAN.
15 16	(3) THE POLICE COMMISSIONER OR DESIGNEE AND THE FIRE CHIEF OR DESIGNEE NEED NOT BE VETERANS.
17 18 19	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
20 21	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day after the date it is enacted.
