City Council Resolution Number 12-0032R, Water Bill Tax Lien Moratorium, calls for a moratorium of the inclusion of properties in City Tax Sales solely based on unpaid water and sewer charges for a period of two years, or until the Department of Public Works and the Department of Finance can demonstrate to the Council that a viable and fair system of billing is in place.
