AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

1 2	Zoning – Conditional Use Convalescent, Nursing, and Rest Home (Substance Abuse Treatment Center) <u>– Variances</u> – 4613 Park Heights Avenue		
3	FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and		
4	operation of a convalescent, nursing, and rest home (substance abuse treatment center) on the		
5	property known as 4613 Park Heights Avenue, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat;		
6 7	and granting variances from certain setback, lot area size and lot area coverage, floor area ratio, off-street parking, and side yard projection requirements.

13	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That		
14	permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a convalescent,		
15	nursing, and rest home (substance abuse treatment center) on the property known as 4613 Park		
16	Heights Avenue, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with		
17	Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 4-904(1) and 14-102, subject to the following conditions:		
18	1. The convalescent, nursing, and rest home (substance abuse treatment center) shall		
19	only be permitted on the first floor of the property.		
20	2. The convalescent, nursing, and rest home (substance abuse treatment center) shall		
21	conform to the site plan known as Exhibit A that is attached to and made part of this		
22	Ordinance approved by the Site Plan Review Committee and the Building Elevations		
23	approved by the Department of Planning.

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1 2 3	3. The convalescent, nursing, and rest home (substance abuse treatment center) must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.		
4 5 6 7	by Title 15 of the Zoning Code of Baltimore City and, specifically, by §§ 15-101 and 15-202, the City Council grants a variance from the lot area requirement of 32,000 square feet to 24,401		
8 9 10	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That pursuant to the authority granted by Title 15 of the Zoning Code of Baltimore City and, specifically, by §§ 15-101 and 15-203, the City Council grants a variance from the interior side yard setback requirement of 15 feet to 5 feet.		
11 12 13	SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That pursuant to the authority granted by Title 15 of the Zoning Code of Baltimore City and, specifically, by §§ 15-101 and 15-204, the City Council grants a variance from the permitted Floor Area Ratio of 1.0 to 1.57.		
14 15 16 17	SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That pursuant to the authority granted by Title 15 of the Zoning Code of Baltimore City and, specifically, by §§ 15-101 and 15-208, the City Council grants a variance from the requirement of 29 vehicle parking spaces to 15 vehicle parking spaces.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That pursuant to the authority granted by Title 15 of the Zoning Code of Baltimore City and, specifically, by §§ 15-101, and 15-218, the City Council grants a variance from the permitted 3-foot side yard projection to a 5-foot side yard projection to the property line.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.		
30 31	SECTION 3 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day after the date it is enacted.
