6	condemnation, the fee simple or other interests in certain property located along the east side
7	of Key Highway, known as 1465 Key Highway, being situate between Fort Avenue and Key
8	Highway East and needed for the Key Highway Shared-Use Trail and Landscape Project, as
9	shown on plats RW20-36294 and RW20-36297 filed in the Office of the Director of the
10	Department of General Services; and providing for a special effective date.

19	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That it is
20	necessary to acquire, for the Key Highway Shared-Use Trail and Landscape Project, the fee
21	simple or other interests that the Director of General Services considers needed or sufficient in the
22	land and improvements located through the property known as 1465 Key Highway, being situate
23	between Fort Avenue and Key Highway East, and more particularly described as follows:
24	1. A Parcel of land as shown on a plat numbered RW20-36294 sheet No. 2 of 6
25	and dated June 26, 2009.
26	2. A Temporary Construction Easement as shown on a plat numbered RW20-
27	36294 sheet No. 2 of 6 and dated June 26, 2009.

1 2	3. A Slope Easement as shown on a plat numbered RW20-36297 sheet No. 5 of 6 and dated June 26, 2009.
3 4	4. A Temporary Construction Easement as shown on a plat numbered RW20-36297 sheet No. 5 of 6 and dated June 26, 2009.
5 6	Together with all right, title, interest, and estate that the owner of that property has in all streets, alleys, ways, or lanes, public or private, contained within or abutting the property.
7	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the Department of Real Estate, or any other
8	person or agency that the Board of Estimates designates, may negotiate and acquire on behalf of the
9	Mayor and City Council of Baltimore the fee simple or other interests in the land and
10	improvements described in this Ordinance as needed or sufficient for the purposes described in
11	this Ordinance. If the Department of Real Estate, or the person or agency otherwise designated by
12	the Board of Estimates, is unable to agree with the owner on the purchase price for the property, it
13	shall promptly notify the City Solicitor, who shall institute the necessary legal proceedings to
14	acquire by condemnation the fee simple or other interests needed or sufficient for the purposes
15	described in this Ordinance.
16	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That proceedings for the acquisition by
17	condemnation of the property described in this Ordinance and all rights of all parties interested or
18	affected shall be in accordance with Title 12 of the Real Property Article of the Maryland Code.
19	SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is

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enacted.
