> City Council Bill 12-0062 - Planned Unit Development -Re: Designation-Holabird Manor Condominium

Dear Mr. President and City Council Members:

City Council Bill 12-0062 repeals the existing Planned Unit Development for Holabird Manor Senior Retirement Community and approves a new Development Plan for the Holabird Manor Condominiums Planned Unit Development. Pursuant to the City Zoning Code ("ZC"), a bill concerning a PUD is classified as a "legislative authorization." ZC § 16-101. Legislative authorizations require certain procedures to be followed in the bill's passage which, among other things, include submission of the bill to the Planning Commission for its review and subsequent report on the legislation. See ZC §§ 16-301& 16-302.

The Law Department believes the information contained in the Planning Commission's report may impact on the legal analysis of the bill. For this reason, the Law Department respectfully requests approval to delay its report on the above bill until we have had an opportunity to review the Planning Commission's report.
