Recommended Position

The Office of the Labor Commissioner (OLC) has reviewed City Council Bill 12-0088, which proposes certain changes in order to ensure compliance with the Internal Revenue Code.

Comments and Analysis

The current bill proposes to take our current retirement provisions and bring them in compliance with certain provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, such as IRC Sec. 401(a)(9) and Sec. 415. In addition, changes are proposed with respect to eligible rollover distributions and Fire and Police non-line-of-duty death benefit.
