BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 12 13 Sheet 56 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the M-2-3 Zoning District to the B-2-3 Zoning District the properties known as 235-239 North Gay Street, as outlined in red 14 on the plat accompanying this Ordinance. 15
 - SECTION 2.
