20	description known, that [discharges] IS DESIGNED TO DISCHARGE OR CAN READILY BE
21	CONVERTED TO DISCHARGE a pellet or other object by [force of gas or air cylinder or
22	cartridge, by action of an explosive or combustible propellant, or by pump action] THE
23	EXPANSION OF GAS OR AIR.

1	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
