| 9 10 | (2) THE FACILITY MUST ENSURE THAT THE LETTER GRADE CARD IS NOT DEFACED, MARRED, CAMOUFLAGED, OR HIDDEN FROM PUBLIC VIEW. |
| 11 | (B) BY COMMISSIONER. |
| 12 13 | THE COMMISSIONER MUST MAINTAIN AND POST ON THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE A SEARCHABLE DATABASE OF FOOD SERVICE FACILITIES THAT CONTAINS: |
| 14 | (1) THE NAME (INCLUDING TRADE NAME) AND ADDRESS OF EACH FACILITY; |
| 15 | (2) THE DATE OF THE FACILITY'S MOST RECENT INSPECTION; AND |
| 16 | (3) THE LETTER GRADE ISSUED ON THAT INSPECTION. |
| 17 | § 6-705. DEFERRING POSTING. |
| 18 | (A) WHEN AUTHORIZED. |
| 19 20 21 22 | IF, ON A REINSPECTION, A FOOD SERVICE FACILITY STILL RECEIVES A GRADE LOWER THAN AN "A" AND IF THE FACILITY TIMELY REQUESTS A HEARING UNDER TITLE 2, SUBTITLE 3 {"ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS"} OF THIS ARTICLE, THE FACILITY MAY DEFER POSTING THE LETTER GRADE CARD UNTIL THE HEARING DATE SCHEDULED BY THE DEPARTMENT. |
| 23 | (B) SUBSTITUTE SIGN. |
| 24 25 26 | IF A FACILITY CHOOSES TO DEFER POSTING THE LETTER GRADE CARD, THE FACILITY MUST REMOVE THE CARD CURRENTLY POSTED AND SUBSTITUTE A SIGN, PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THAT ADVISES THE PUBLIC THAT: |
| 27 | (1) THE FACILITIES INSPECTION RESULT IS UNDER REVIEW; AND |
| 28 | (2) THE RESULTS OF THE INSPECTION CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE DEPARTMENT. |
| 29 | (C) QUALIFICATIONS. |
| 30 | (1) THE DEFERMENT TERMINATES IF THE FACILITY: |

| 1 2 | (I) FAILS TO APPEAR AT THE HEARING SCHEDULED UNDER TITLE 2, SUBTITLE 3 {"ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS"} OF THIS ARTICLE; |
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| 3 4 | (II) REQUESTS A POSTPONEMENT OF THE HEARING TO A DATE ON WHICH THE FACILITY IS UNABLE TO PROCEED; OR |
| 5 | (III) OTHERWISE EMPLOYS DILATORY TACTICS TO DELAY THE HEARING. |
| 6 7 | (2) IN ANY OF THESE EVENTS, THE FACILITY MUST IMMEDIATELY POST THE LETTER GRADE CARD ISSUED AT THE REINSPECTION. |

| 16 17 18 | [(1)] A food SERVICE facility or other establishment that has had its license suspended for longer than 24 hours must post a public notice OF THE SUSPENSION throughout the suspension period [stating the reason for the suspension]. |
| 19 | (B) FORM AND TENOR. |
| 20 | [(2)] The notice must: |
| 21 | (1) be in the form and tenor that the Commissioner specifies; AND |
| 22 | (2) STATE THE REASON FOR THE SUSPENSION. |
| 23 | § 6-712. Published listings of revocations, suspensions, and closings. |
| 24 | (A) [(b) Published listings] COMMISSIONER TO PUBLISH MONTHLY LISTING. |
| 25 26 27 | [(1)] At least monthly, the Commissioner must publish a list of food SERVICE facilities and other establishments that, during the preceding calendar month, have had their licenses suspended or revoked or that have been closed for health code violations. |
| 28 | (B) CONTENTS OF LISTING. |
| 29 | [(2)] The listing must specify: |
| 30 | (1) [(i)] the name (including trade name) and address of the establishment; |

| 1 | (2) [(ii)] the effective date and term of the revocation, suspension, or closing; and |
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| 2 | (3) [(iii)] the reasons for the revocation, suspension, or closing. |
| 3 | (C) HOW PUBLISHED. |
| 4 | [(3)] The listing must be published by: |
| 5 | (1) [(i)] posting on the Department's website; and |
| 6 7 | (2) [(ii)] distribution to the neighborhood association(s) listed with the Department of Planning for the area(s) served by the establishment. |
| 8 9 10 | SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance. |
| 11 12 | SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day after the date it is enacted. |
