24 25 26	The sum of \$1,551,566, as appropriated to various City agencies in the Fiscal 2013 Ordinance of Estimates, is not needed for the purpose for which it was appropriated and, therefore, is available for transfer to other agencies.
27 28	On August 8, 2012, the Board of Estimates recommended the transfer authorized by this Ordinance.
