15 16 17	Article VI, § 9(a)(2) of the City Charter provides that, on recommendation of the Board of Estimates, the City Council by ordinance may authorize the transfer of an appropriation contained in the Ordinance of Estimates from one municipal agency to another municipal agency.
18 19 20 21	The sum of \$300,000, as appropriated to the M-R: Miscellaneous General Expenses (Program 122 - Miscellaneous General Expenses) in the Fiscal 2013 Ordinance of Estimates, is not needed for the purpose for which it was appropriated and, therefore, is available for transfer to another agency.
22 23	On October 24, 2012, the Board of Estimates recommended the transfer authorized by this Ordinance.
