Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the East Baltimore Development Incorporated in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2013.

 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2013 was formulated.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
 \$69,617 shall be made available to the Mayor's Office of Employment Development – Service
 797 (Career Center Services) as a Supplementary Special Fund Operating Appropriation for
 Fiscal Year 2013, to provide funding for job readiness, remedial education, and occupational
 outcomes for target populations within the East Baltimore Development Pipeline. The source of
