### Zoning – Conditional Use Second-hand Store – 566 Oldtown Mall

- FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and
  operation of a second-hand store on the property known as 566 Oldtown Mall, as outlined in
  red on the accompanying plat.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a second-hand store on the property known as 566 Oldtown Mall, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this

14 Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 6-309(12a) and 14-102, subject to

15 the condition that the second-hand store complies with all applicable federal, state, and local

16 licensing and certification requirements.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED. That as evidence of the authenticity of the 17 18 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning 19 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 20 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 21 22 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of 23 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator. 24
