4	Provided, however, that no license shall be required of any agent duly authorized in			
5	writing by a licensed exhibitor to sell tickets for said licensee [at the established price			
6	printed thereon].			
7	[§ 21-2. Maximum service charge.			
8	A licensee under this section, or any officer or employee thereof, shall not directly or			
9	indirectly exact, accept, or receive for any ticket or token of admission to an exhibition,			
10	performance, game, or sport conducted by a licensee under a license granted by the State of			
1	Maryland, or the City of Baltimore, any greater amount than 50¢ in excess of the sum of the			
12	regular or established price or charge therefor printed on the face of such ticket, plus the			
13 14	amount of any tax imposed by the Government of the United States or by the State of Maryland upon such ticket or the right of admission thereunder.]			
15	[§ 21-3. "Scalping" prohibited.			
16	(a) Price to be on ticket.			
17	Wherever the right of admission to any licensed exhibition or performance or to any game			
18	or sport where a charge is made is evidenced by a ticket, card, or other token, the regular			
19	or established price or charge therefor shall be conspicuously printed thereon.			
20	(b) Sale for more prohibited; penalties.			
21	(1) If such licensee, or any of his officers or employees, shall extract, accept, or receive,			
22	directly or indirectly, any greater amount than such regular or established price or			
23	charge, plus the amount of any tax imposed by the Government of the United States			
24	or the State of Maryland:			
25	(i) the license of such licensee may be revoked and annulled; and			
26	(ii) such licensee, officer, or employees shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and,			
27	upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$500 for			
28	each such violation.			
29	(2) The sale of each ticket in violation thereof shall constitute a separate offense.]

3 4 5 6 7	Nothing in this section [shall] MAY be construed to make illegal or invalidate [the excess sum which is permitted to be charged for certain tickets] A SERVICE CHARGE IMPOSED BY OR STATE OR LOCAL TAXES COLLECTED by a person [engaged in the business of selling] LICENSED TO SELL tickets (OR THAT PERSON'S AUTHORIZED AGENT) under the provisions of Article 15, Subtitle 21 {"Ticket Agencies"} of the City Code.		
8 9 10	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.		
11 12 13 14 15	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted. It will remain in effect until November September 1, 2013, on which date, with no further action by the Mayor and City Council: (i) this Ordinance will be abrogated and of no further effect; and (ii) the provisions repealed or amended by this Ordinance will be revived and again come into full force and effect as they were before the enactment of this Ordinance.
