Re: **City Council Bill 12-0165 – Baltimore City Landmark List – Florence Crittenton Home**

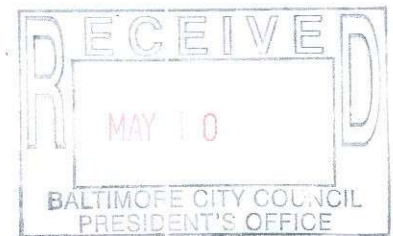
The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 12-0165, which was introduced for the purpose of designating the Florence Crittenton Home, 3110 Crittenton Place, as a historical landmark.

This bill, if enacted, would add the property known as 3110 Crittenton Place—the Florence Crittenton Home—to the Baltimore City Landmark List. The subject property is located in the Hampden neighborhood, and the site is presently vacant.
