# AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

1	<b>Commercial Vehicle Monitoring System – Establishment</b>
2	FOR the purpose of authorizing the use of commercial vehicle monitoring systems, subject to
3	certain standards, procedures, requirements, and limitations; authorizing certain civil
4	penalties for violations; mandating the issuance of a warning for a first offense; defining
5	certain terms; requiring certain rules and regulations; and providing for a special effective
6	date.

13	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
14	Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

17	SUBTITLE 34. COMMERCIAL VEHICLE MONITORING SYSTEM
18	§ 34-1. DEFINITIONS.
19	(A) IN GENERAL.
20	IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law. <u>Underlining</u> indicates matter added to the bill by amendment. Strike out indicates matter stricken from the bill by amendment or deleted from existing law by amendment.

- 1 (B) COMMERCIAL VEHICLE MONITORING SYSTEM.
- 2 "COMMERCIAL VEHICLE MONITORING SYSTEM" MEANS A MONITORING SYSTEM
   3 AUTHORIZED BY THE ENABLING LAW TO ENFORCE LOCAL RESTRICTIONS ON THE PRESENCE
   4 OF CERTAIN VEHICLES IN CERTAIN PLACES DURING CERTAIN TIMES.
- 5 (C) ENABLING LAW.
- 6 "ENABLING LAW" MEANS STATE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE § 24-111.3.

### 7 § 34-2. USE OF SYSTEM AUTHORIZED.

- 8 THE USE OF A COMMERCIAL VEHICLE MONITORING SYSTEM IS AUTHORIZED IN BALTIMORE
   9 CITY TO ENFORCE RESTRICTIONS ON THE PRESENCE OF CERTAIN VEHICLES IN CERTAIN PLACES
   10 DURING CERTAIN TIMES.
- 11 § 34-3. GOVERNING STANDARDS, ETC.
- 12 (A) IN GENERAL.

A COMMERCIAL VEHICLE MONITORING SYSTEM MAY NOT BE USED EXCEPT IN
 ACCORDANCE WITH AND SUBJECT TO THE PREREQUISITES, STANDARDS, PROCEDURES,
 REQUIREMENTS, LIMITATIONS, AND OTHER PROVISIONS OF:

- 16 (1) THE STATE ENABLING LAW; AND
- 17 (2) THIS SUBTITLE AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS
   18 SUBTITLE.
- 19 (B) MAXIMUM NUMBER OF OPERATIONAL CAMERAS.
- 20 NO MORE THAN 6 CAMERAS MAY BE OPERATIONAL AT ANY ONE TIME.

#### 21 **§ 34-5. ENFORCEMENT.**

A VIOLATION RECORDED BY A COMMERCIAL VEHICLE MONITORING SYSTEM IS ENFORCEABLE
 AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE ENABLING LAW.

#### 24 **§ 34-6. FINE PROCEEDS.**

THE FINES THAT THE CITY COLLECTS THROUGH A COMMERCIAL VEHICLE MONITORING SYSTEM
 MAY BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY ONLY FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THE STATE ENABLING
 LAW.

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### 1 § 34-7. RULES AND REGULATIONS.

- 2 (A) IN GENERAL.
- THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT MAY JOINTLY
   DEVELOP AND ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO GOVERN THE IMPLEMENTATION AND
   USE OF A COMMERCIAL VEHICLE MONITORING SYSTEM.
- 6 (B) COVERAGE.
- 7 THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS MAY, AMONG OTHER THINGS, ESTABLISH PROCEDURES
  8 AND STANDARDS FOR:
- 9 (1) THE PROCUREMENT OF SYSTEM DEVICES;
- 10 (2) THE EMPLOYMENT OR PROCUREMENT OF SYSTEM OPERATORS; AND
- 11 (3) THE PLACEMENT AND OPERATION OF SYSTEM DEVICES.
- 12 (C) TO BE COMPLIANT WITH ENABLING LAW.
- ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MUST BE COMPLIANT WITH
   THE STATE ENABLING LAW.
- 15 (D) PUBLIC COMMENT.
- 16 (1) ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS PROPOSED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MUST BE PUBLISHED
   17 FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE WEBSITE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
   18 FOR AT LEAST 30 DAYS.
- (2) AFTER THIS COMMENT PERIOD, THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE
   POLICE DEPARTMENT MAY MODIFY THE PROPOSED RULES AND REGULATIONS AND
   ADOPT FINAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.
- 22 (E) FILING WITH LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE.
- A COPY OF ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MUST BE FILED
   WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BEFORE THEY TAKE EFFECT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
   are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
   Ordinance.
- 28 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the later of 29 (i) the date on which this Ordinance is enacted or (ii) October 1, 2012.
