SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That Sheet 45 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the B-2-3 Zoning District to the B-5-1 Zoning District the properties known as 890 Linden Avenue, 905, 909, and 911 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, and 855 and 857 North Eutaw Street, as outlined in red on the plat

17 accompanying this Ordinance.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the 19 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council 20 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 21 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 22 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of 23 24 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 25 the Zoning Administrator.
