13	known as 501 Orkney Road (Block 5136A, Lot 011), and more particularly described as follows:	
14	The subject parcel, more particularly described as Block 5136A, Lot 11, is an	
15	improved lot, with a residential structure on it that contains approximately 2,280	
16	square feet of enclosed area. The property is located on the south side of Orkney

18	of the south side of Orkney Avenue (aka Orkney Road) with the east side of York	
19	Road and contains approximately 9,997 square feet of land area.
