- The sums to be transferred from the agency services designated in this Ordinance are not needed for the purpose for which they were appropriated and, therefore, are available for transfer
- 19 to another agency.
- On July 24, 2013, the Board of Estimates recommended the transfer authorized by this Ordinance.
