Recitals

Article VI, § 9(a)(2) of the City Charter provides that, on recommendation of the Board of
 Estimates, the City Council by ordinance may authorize the transfer of an appropriation contained
 in the Ordinance of Estimates from one municipal agency to another municipal agency.

The sum of \$160,000, as appropriated to the Department of General Services (Service 731:
Facilities Management) in the Fiscal 2014 Ordinance of Estimates, is not needed for the purpose
for which it was appropriated and, therefore, is available for transfer to another agency.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
 sum of \$160,000, contained in the Fiscal 2014 Ordinance of Estimates as a General Fund
 Appropriation, is transferred from the Department of General Services (Service 731: Facilities
 Management) to the State's Attorney (Service 115: Prosecution of Criminals).
