1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Parking Facilities – Redefined**

3 FOR the purpose of redefining “parking facility”, as that term is used in the law providing for the
4 licensing and regulation of certain facilities used for the parking, storage, housing, or keeping
5 of certain vehicles.

6 BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14 **Article 15. Licensing and Regulation**

15 **Subtitle 12. Parking Facilities – Generally**

16 **§ 12-1. Definitions; Scope.**

17 (a) *Definitions.*

18 (2) *Parking facility.*

19 “Parking facility” means any:

- 20 (i) garage, structure, or part of a structure for the parking, storage,
21 housing, or keeping of 3 or more motor vehicles in exchange for a
22 fee [or other consideration]; or

1 (ii) parking lot or outdoor area or space for the parking, storage,
2 housing, or keeping of 3 or more motor vehicles in exchange for a
3 fee [or other consideration].

4 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
5 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
6 Ordinance.

7 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
8 after the date it is enacted.
