- 26 needed for the purpose for which it was appropriated and, therefore, is available for transfer to
- 27 another agency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the sum of \$1,078,000, contained in the Fiscal 2014 Ordinance of Estimates as a Video Lottery 4 Terminal Capital Appropriation, is transferred from the Department of Housing and Community 5 6 Development (Account #9910-905962-9587) to the Department of Recreation and Parks 7 (Account #9938-918032-9475 - \$453,000), to the Department of Transportation (Account #9950-8 916050-9528 - \$380,000), to Baltimore Development Corporation (Account #9910-921100-9600 - \$130,000), and to the Department of General Services (Account #9916-920020-9194 -9 \$115,000) to fund Northwest Neighborhood Improvements capital projects. 10
