3	FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the
4	amount of \$200,000 to the Department of Recreation and Parks – Service 654 (Urban
5	Forestry), to provide funding to allow the Department of Recreation and Parks to collaborate
6	with multiple partners, including Baltimore City Public Schools, to create a system-wide
7	process that merges existing Maryland Service-Learning standards with new Environmental
8	Literacy standards, to apply to park and schoolyard restorations; and providing for a special
9	effective date.

16	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Maryland
17	Department of Natural Resources Students Restoring Urban Streams Initiative, in excess of the
18	revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the
19	budget for Fiscal Year 2014.
20	That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of
21	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated.
22	On October 9, 2013, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
23	Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That \$200,000 shall be made available to the Department of Recreation and Parks – Service 654 (Urban Forestry) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2014, to provide funding to allow the Department of Recreation and Parks to collaborate with multiple partners, including Baltimore City Public Schools, to create a system-wide process that merges existing Maryland Service-Learning standards with new Environmental Literacy standards, to apply to park and schoolyard restorations. The source of revenue for this appropriation is the grant from Maryland Department of Natural Resources Students Restoring Urban Streams Initiative in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2014.
