- 4 (Block 0041, Lot 008) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special 5 effective date.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in 12 accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either

13 public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property

14 known as 1114-1150 North Mount Street (Block 0041, Lot 008), and more particularly described

- 15 as follows:
- 16 The subject parcel is a vacant school,
- 17 containing 1.502 acres, more or less, this property being no longer needed for public use.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance
  unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
- 20 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 21 enacted.
