13	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in	
14	accordance with Article V, § 5(b) Article II, § 15(c) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller	
15	Commissioner of Housing and Community Development may sell, at either public or private	
16	sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property known as 3814	
17	Ednor Road (Ward 9, Section 22, Block 3972N, Lot 026), and more particularly described as	
18	follows:	
19	The property is a 20-foot by 105-foot 6-inch improved lot (approximately 2,112	
20	square feet), on which is an attached 2-story brick row house in the Ednor	
21	Gardens neighborhood, and the property is zoned R-6. The row house enclosed	
22	area is approximately 1,200 square feet and includes 3 bedrooms and 1.5	
23	bathrooms. The property came under the control of the City via a Deed of	
24	Surrender and Conveyance recorded in Liber 11749, folio 167.	
25	This property being no longer needed for public use.
