City Council Bill 13-0300- Zoning - Conditional Use Second-hand Store -2007-2009

West Pratt Street

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 13-0300, which was introduced for the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a second-hand store on the property known as 2007-2009 West Pratt Street.

City Council Bill 13-0300, if approved, would allow for the establishment of a second-hand store on the street level of the three-story commercial building at 2007-2009 West Pratt Street. The space was occupied by a retail sales shop for clothing and shoes but is currently vacant. The proposed use will be for second-hand sales of clothing, household furniture and appliances and related merchandise.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the adoption of City Council Bill 13-0300.
