City Council Bill 14 - 0330

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 14-0330, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and closing certain streets and alleys bounded by East 21st Street, Greenmount Avenue, East 20th Street, and Barclay Street (Ward 12, Section 12, Block 3805), as shown on Plat 91-A-52A in the Office of the Department of General Services; and providing for a special effective date.

City Council Bill 14-0330, if approved, would close streets and alleys to public use and companion City Council Bill 14-0331, would authorize their sale to facilitate the continued phased revitalization of the Barclay and Old Goucher neighborhoods by Telesis Corporation. The phased development will transform the neighborhood into a stable, mixed-income community with quality open spaces, community facilities and employment opportunities.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the adoption of City Council Bill 14-0330.
