#### Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from General Fund Drug and
 Gambling Contraband Revenue in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in
 determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2014.

- This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
  Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated.
- 19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the 20 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated or is for a new program that could 21 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
- On April 23, 2014, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
  Council.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
 \$950,800 shall be made available to the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice – Service 758
 (Coordination of Public Safety Strategy) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating
