23 24	Subtitle 1. Indoor Smoking § 12-101. Definitions.
25	(a) In general.
26	In this subtitle, the following terms have the meanings indicated.
27	(B) ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE.
28	(1) IN GENERAL.
29 30 31	"ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE" MEANS AN ELECTRONIC OR BATTERY-OPERATED DEVICE THAT DELIVERS VAPORS FOR INHALATION, WHETHER MANUFACTURED, DISTRIBUTED, MARKETED, OR SOLD:
32	(I) AS AN ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE, ELECTRONIC CIGAR, OR ELECTRONIC PIPE; OR
33	(II) BY ANY OTHER PRODUCT NAME OR DESCRIPTOR.

1	(2) EXCLUSIONS.
2 3	"ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE" DOES NOT INCLUDE AN ASTHMA INHALER OR SIMILAR PRODUCT THAT:
4	(I) CONTAINS NO TOBACCO NOR ANY NICOTINE; AND
5 6 7	(II) HAS BEEN SPECIFICALLY APPROVED BY THE U.S. FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION FOR USE IN MITIGATING, TREATING, OR PREVENTING DISEASE.
8	(C) [(b)] Enclosed area.
9 10	(1) "Enclosed area" means an area that is bounded on all sides by walls that extend, with or without doors, windows, vents, or like openings, from floor to ceiling.
11	(2) "Enclosed area" includes the interior of a vehicle.
12	(D) [(c)] Person in charge.
13 14	"Person in charge" means the person who owns, operates, or manages a place subject to this subtitle.
15	(E) [(d)] <i>Smoke</i> .
16	"Smoke" means to:
17 18	(1) inhale, burn, or carry any lighted cigarette, cigar, OR pipe tobacco, or ANY other tobacco, weed, or plant product of any kind; or
19 20	(2) TO INHALE VAPORS FROM OR OTHERWISE ALLOW VAPORS TO BE EMITTED FROM AN ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE.

23	(a) In general.
24	In this subtitle, the following terms have the meanings indicated.
25	(B) ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE.
26 27	"ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN \S 12-101 {"DEFINITIONS"} OF THIS TITLE.

1	(C) [(b)] Tobacco product.
2	(1) In general.
3	"Tobacco product" means any substance that contains tobacco.
4	(2) Inclusions.
5	"Tobacco product" includes any:
6	(i) cigarette;
7	(ii) cigar;
8	(iii) bidi;
9	(iv) pipe or other smoking tobacco; or
10	(v) chewing tobacco, spit tobacco, snuff, or other smokeless tobacco.
11	§ 12-402. Placement requirements — In general.
12	(a) Prohibited placement.
13	Except as otherwise specified in this subtitle, no establishment that sells tobacco products
14 15	OR ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES at retail may display, store, or place any tobacco
15 16	product OR ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE anywhere that is accessible to customers without the intervention of the seller or an employee of the seller.
17	(b) Examples of complying placement.
18	The display, storage, or placement of tobacco products OR ELECTRONIC SMOKING
19	DEVICES in accord with one of the following methods does not violate subsection (a)
20	of this section:
21	(1) behind a sales counter in a place that, absent extraordinary efforts, is beyond
22	the physical reach of customers;
23 24	(2) in a locked display case for which seller assistance is needed to gain access to
24	products in the case; or
25	(3) in an overhead merchandise rack that:
26	(i) at its lowest point, is at least 6 feet above the floor; and
27	(ii) permits access to products in the rack only from the side facing away
28	from customers.

1	§ 12-403. Placement requirements — Exceptions.
2	This subtitle does not apply to:
3 4 5	(1) the sale of tobacco products OR ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES from a vending machine that complies with all requirements of State Business Regulation Article, Title 16, Subtitle 3A; or
6	(2) an establishment that:
7 8	(i) sells tobacco products OR ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES exclusively or primarily; and
9	(ii) makes bona fide efforts to prevent minors from entering the establishment.
10	Subtitle 5. Distribution to Minors
11	§ 12-501. Definitions.
12	(a) In general.
13	In this subtitle, the following terms have the meanings indicated.
14	(B) ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE.
15 16	"Electronic smoking device" has the meaning stated in $\$ 12-101 {"Definitions"} of this title.
17	(C) [(b)] Distribute.
18	"Distribute" means to:
19	(1) give away, sell, deliver, dispense, or issue;
20	(2) offer to give away, sell, deliver, dispense, or issue; or
21	(3) cause or hire any person to:
22	(i) give away, sell, deliver, dispense, or issue; or
23	(ii) offer to give away, sell, deliver, dispense, or issue.
24	(D) [(c)] Tobacco product.
25	(1) In general.
26	"Tobacco product" means any substance that contains tobacco.

1	(2) Inclusions.
2	"Tobacco product" includes any:
3	(i) cigarette;
4	(ii) cigar;
5	(iii) bidi;
6	(iv) pipe or other smoking tobacco; or
7	(v) chewing tobacco, spit tobacco, snuff, or other smokeless tobacco.
8	§ 12-502. Unlawful distribution.
9	(a) Persons in business.
10 11	A person engaged in the business of selling or otherwise distributing tobacco products OF ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES for commercial purposes may not:
12 13 14	 distribute any tobacco product OR ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES to a minor, unless the minor is acting solely as the agent of an employer engaged in the business of distributing [tobacco] THOSE products OR DEVICES;
15	(2) distribute any cigarette rolling paper to a minor; or
16 17	(3) distribute to a minor any coupon redeemable for any tobacco product OR ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE.
18	(b) Others.
19	A person not described in subsection (a) of this section may not:
20 21	(1) buy for or sell to a minor any tobacco product OR ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICE; or
22	(2) buy for or sell or deliver to a minor any cigarette rolling paper.
