City Council Bill 14 - 0357

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 14-0357, which was introduced for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as 1220 East Oliver Street (Block 1123, Lot 017) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The property is located on the northeastern corner of the intersection with Harford Road. The property is improved by a 2 1/2 story building that was built as a firehouse in 1905 and was closed in 2000 and transferred to HCD via the surplus program.

If City Council Bill 14-0357 is adopted it would allow HCD the authority to sell the vacant property through a competitive process. The competitive process would provide all interested parties an opportunity to submit offers and creative proposals for review to insure the highest and best use for redevelopment and compatibility with the neighborhood.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the adoption of City Council Bill 14-0357.
