11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in		
12	accordance with Article II, § 15(c) of the City Charter, the Commissioner of Housing and		
13	Community Development may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor		
14	and City Council of Baltimore in the property known as 31 South Payson Street (Block 0224, Lot		
15	016), and more particularly described as follows:		
16	The subject property is a vacant building, located in the Booth Boyd		
17	neighborhood, that was formerly used as an Enoch Pratt Free Library and has an		
18	enclosed area of 13,372 square feet. When the library closed, the building was		
19	surplussed to the Department of Housing and Community Development.		
20	This property being no longer needed for public use.		
21	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance		
22	unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.		
23	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is		
24	enacted.
