13	Recitals
14	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from Transfer Tax surplus in
15 16	excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2014.
17	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
18	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated.
19	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
20	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated or is for a new program that could
21	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
22	On June 11, 2014, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
23	Council.
24	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
25	\$12,500,000 shall be made available to the Department of Transportation – Service 688 (Snow
26	and Ice Removal) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year

1	2014, to provide funding for additional operating expenses. The source of revenue for this
2	appropriation is funds from Transfer Tax surplus in excess of the amount from this source that
3	was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the
4	budget for Fiscal Year 2014.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
