Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from General Fund Drug and 12 Gambling Contraband Revenue in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in 13 determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2014. 14

15 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated. 16

17 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated or is for a new program that could 18 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated. 19

On April 23, 2014, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City 20 21 Council.

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That \$1,239,800 shall be made available to the Police Department – Service 622 (Police Patrol) as a 23 Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2014, to provide funding 24
