RE: City Council Bill No. 14-0400-Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation-Department of Transportation - \$12,500,000

Dear President and Members

You have requested the advice of the Law Department regarding City Council Bill 14-0400. City Council Bill 14-0400 provides for a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for the Department of Transportation to provide funding for additional operating expenses related to snow and ice removal.

Under Art. VI, Sec. 8(b) of the Charter of Baltimore City, "additional appropriations shall be permitted during the fiscal year only in the following circumstances and under the following conditions:

(1) Excess revenues.

Revenues from any source other than the full rate property tax and other taxes imposed under the authority of Article II, in excess of or in addition to those relied upon by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget, may be made available for expenditure by the municipal agency responsible for the production of such revenues by a supplementary appropriation ordinance....

(2) Unanticipated grants.

Grants from private or governmental sources which could not be expected with reasonable certainty at the time of the formulation of the proposed Ordinance of Estimates may be made available to the appropriate municipal agency for expenditure by a supplementary appropriation ordinance

(3) Material changes; new programs.

Further appropriations for programs included in the proposed Ordinance of Estimates made necessary by a material change in circumstances, or additional appropriations for new programs which could not reasonably be anticipated at the time of the formulation of the proposed

Ordinance of Estimates may be made available to the appropriate municipal agency for expenditure by a supplementary appropriation

City Council Bill 14-0400 satisfies the requirements of Sec. 8(b) of the Charter and, therefore, is consistent with the authority of the City Council. Sec. 8(c) also requires that a supplementary appropriation ordinance shall provide the revenue necessary to pay the appropriation by a source, other than the full rate property tax. The bill does provide for an appropriate source of the revenue.

Based on the foregoing, the Law Department approves City Council Bill 14-0400 for form and legal sufficiency.
