The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 14-0393 for the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 2700 Rayner Avenue from the R-6 Zoning District to the O-R-2 Zoning District.

City Council Bill 14-0393, if approved, would rezone the property to support the Coppin Heights Community Development Corporation's plans to rehabilitate the vacant building for a neighborhood health clinic, operated by Total Health Care, Incorporated.
