9 10	<b>SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE</b> , That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

12	Article 31. Transit and Traffic
13	Subtitle 31. Clear Streets and Impoundment
14	§ 31-26. Immobilization - Release on payment of booting fee, etc.
15	(a) In general.
16	The owner of an immobilized vehicle may secure release of the vehicle on payment of:
17	(1) a booting fee of [\$100] \$150; and
18 19	(2) all charges that have accrued on the vehicle, including collateral equivalent to the maximum fines and penalties for all unsatisfied parking violation citations.
