7 8 9	3. [2.] The housing for the elderly must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.
9 10 11	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That pursuant to the authority granted by Title 15 of the Zoning Code of Baltimore City, and
12 13	specifically by §§ 15-101 and 15-203, the City Council grants a variance from the rear yard setback requirement of 30 feet to $[5.5] \frac{29}{25}$ feet.
