Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation – 1 2 **Department of Transportation – \$818,461** 3 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the 4 amount of \$818,461 to the Department of Transportation – Service 683 (Street Management), 5 to provide funding for additional operating expenses; and providing for a special effective 6 date. 7 BY authority of 8 Article VI - Board of Estimates 9 Section 8(b)(3) and (c) 10 Baltimore City Charter (1996 Edition) 11 Recitals 12 13 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from State Highway User Revenues in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax 14 levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2014. 15 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of 16 17 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated. 18 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated or is for a new program that could 19 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated. 20 On June 11, 2014, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City 21

22 Council.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That \$818,461 shall be made available to the Department of Transportation – Service 683 (Street Management) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2014, to provide funding for additional operating expenses. The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from State Highway User Revenues in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2014.

8 **SECTION 2.** AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 9 enacted.
