Ladies and Gentlemen:

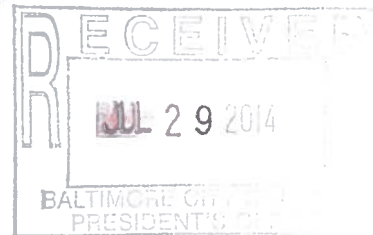
City Council Bill No. 14-0361 has been referred by your Honorable Body to the Board of
Municipal and Zoning Appeals for study and report.

The purpose of City Council Bill No. 14-0361 is to repeal exceptions for certain multiple
businesses from the application, notice, objections, and hearing processes otherwise
required to obtain and renew late-night operations licenses; providing for the application
of the Ordinance to multiple businesses previously licenses under these exceptions;
providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the licensing and
regulation of late-night commercial operations..
