RE: City Council Bill 14-0371 – Electronic Smoking Devices

Analysis

City Council Bill 14-0371 proposes to extend the laws prohibiting smoking in certain places and other restriction on the distribution of tobacco products to minors, display, storage, and placement of tobacco products, to be applied to electronic smoking devices as defined in the legislation.

The legislation proposes that all penalties applied on the Environmental and Civil Citations violations as defined section 14 in the subtitles 40 and 41 of the City Code to also be applied on smoking devices.

Fiscal Impact

The Department of Finance estimates that passage of the proposed legislation will not have a significant fiscal impact since the number of potential violations subject to the proposed bill will not substantial.

Recommendation

The department supports City Council Bill 14-0371
