SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the properties known as 17, 19, and 23 South Gay Street (Ward 04, Section 11, Block 1351, Lots 014, 015, and 016), and more particularly described as follows:

- 17 The subject parcels, 17, 19, and 23 South Gay Street (Block 1351, Lots 014, 015, 18 and 016) are improved lots containing 0.3 acres, more or less.
- 19 These properties being no longer needed for public use.
- 20 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance 21 unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
