11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in		
12	accordance with Article II § 15(c) of the City Charter, the Commissioner of Housing and		
13	Community Development may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor		
14	and City Council of Baltimore in the property known as 5000 Gwynn Oak Avenue (Block 8308,		
15	Lot 001), and more particularly described as follows:		
16	The subject property, located in the Howard Park neighborhood within an R-2		
17	Zoning District, is an irregularly shaped lot of roughly 141' by 194.5' that is an		
18	improved lot with a single-story school annex building that has an enclosed area		
19	of 10,206 square feet, and with the lot itself being 24,398 square feet. The City		
20	acquired the property by a deed dated July 18, 1969, and it is currently coded to		
21	Education.		
22	This property being no longer needed for public use.		
23	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance		
24	unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
