13	Community Development may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor		
14 15	and City Council of Baltimore in the property known as 720 Pennsylvania Avenue (Block 0544, Lot 022 <u>002</u>), and more particularly described as follows:		
16	The subject property is an irregularly shaped, unimproved lot of approximately		
17	48,046.68 square feet (or 1.103 acres) in the Orchard-Biddle neighborhood, and it		
18	is currently zoned R-9.		
19	This property being no longer needed for public use.		
20	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance		
21	unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.
