

As requested, we have reviewed the subject bill for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interests in a certain property known as the former beds of a 3-foot alley and a 4-foot alley bounded by West 29<sup>th</sup> Street, Fox Street, West 28<sup>th</sup> Street and Huntingdon Avenue and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

HKMJB Investments LLC owns all but one of the sites surrounding the above mentioned alleys which are located on Block 3651see attached. These alleys separate the owner's business (liquor store) from the store's parking lots. HKMJB has requested the alleys be closed to public use so they may be purchased and consolidated with their adjoining properties. Companion Bill 14-460 would authorize the closing of the alleyways. The abutting owner of 2845 Huntingdon Avenue has consented to the closure.

The Department of Real Estate has no objections to the passage of City Council Bill 14-0461.
