
Council Bill 15-0481



I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 15-0481 introduced by Council President Young and Councilmembers Kraft, Spector, Branch, Costello, Henry, Reisinger, Welch, and Scott.

The purpose of this bill is to increase the fine, without requiring a prior warning, for vehicles that park, stop, or stand in a manner that obstructs or impedes the free flow of traffic by school grounds during certain hours; clarifying correcting, and conforming related language; and generally relating to the imposition of fines for obstructing or impeding the free flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic.

The Parking Authority of Baltimore City (PABC) reviewed the proposed legislation and, because it deals primarily with issues of traffic safety, we will defer to the comments submitted by the Baltimore City Department of Transportation.
