10 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the 11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14	Subtitle 10. Motor Fuel Sales
15	§ 10-3. Motor fuel service station facilities.
16	(c) Free services required.
17 18	After January 1, 1980, every retail dealer licensed under this subtitle who opens a new motor fuel service station shall provide free of charge to patrons the following:
19	(1) toilet facilities and hand washing facilities maintained in good working order a

- (1) toilet facilities and hand washing facilities maintained in good working order and sanitary conditions;
 - (2) hand towels at every self-service island for the use of patrons;

7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
 8 after the date it is enacted.
