SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 12

- 13 Sheet 14 of the Zoning District Maps is amended by changing from the M-1-1 Zoning District to
- the B-2-3 Zoning District the properties known as 2001, 2011, 2013, 2105, 2107, and 2201 West 14
- Cold Spring Lane (Block 3357E, Lots 001, 005A, 005B, 006, 007/009, 009A), as outlined in red 15
- on the plat accompanying this Ordinance. 16

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the 17 18 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council 19 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; 20 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the 21 22 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and 23 24 the Zoning Administrator.
