## Subtitle 13. Landmark List - 2010s

## § 13-36. JOHN RuHRah Elementary Middle School (SCHOOL \#228).

John Ruhrah Elementary Middle School (School \#228), 701 Rappolla Street.
SECTION 2. AND BE it FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
