- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the 17 Department of General Services shall proceed to condemn and open 2 10-foot alleys between
- 18 Lafayette Avenue, Lanvale Street, Barclay Street, and Greenmount Avenue, and more
- 19 particularly described as follows:
