
Labor and employment - Human Trafficking Whistleblower Prevention

The Baltimore Hotel Corporation (BHC) has reviewed Council Bill 15-0524 for the purpose of prohibiting retaliation against employees of certain employers for reporting suspected human trafficking; defining certain terms; providing for certain penalties; and generally relating to employee reports of suspected human trafficking.

BHC did not support the underlying proposed legislation for Hotels – Human Trafficking Prevention, Council Bill 14-0464. If Council Bill 14-0464 were to pass, BHC would support the Human Trafficking Whistleblower Prevention legislation as the language contained in that Bill would give protection to a person who unwilling witnesses and reports Human Trafficking.
